We have arranged a dinner at Watermark Glenelg on Saturday 12th February for 6 pm – 6:30 pm.



CCSA DINNER-THE HOUSE OF TIEN



Reduced price \$5 (pay on the day) if you pre-register. <u>www.corvetteclubofsouthaustralia.com.au</u>. This also entitles your vehicle to be judged by other entrants & the public. Pre registered vehicles must display their sticker prior to entry as there will be a priority queue. There will be a separate queue for vehicles not pre – registered, fee \$10 & details will need to be collected to comply with COVID requirements. Correct money would be greatly appreciated to minimise cash handling. Vehicles need to arrive between 9am – 9.45am. Due to Council Regulations, no car can enter after 9.45 am or leave before 3.00 pm for the safety of the viewing public. Spectators free. Live Band playing music. It is to be a fun event and people are encouraged to bring fold up chairs & picnic gear if they wish and they will have the opportunity to socialise with other Corvette owners.






