

It is always with great sadness we farewell a long standing member of our club and lan was certainly one.

Although we do not have the exact date we estimate he joined the Corvette Club in the late 90's and held the position of Public Officer for several years. With a passion and involvement in all things mechanical which began as an Aircraft Engineer during WWII stationed on Malluka Island, in Indonesia Territory, he worked on the famous Merlin V12 engines in the P-51 Mustang.


His passion for the Chevrolet continued throughout his life with his son Tim recounting a memorable trip from Adelaide to Perth in a brand new '54 Belair with Mum, Dad, six kids along with Auntie Pat and Uncle Jim. His favourite Chev however was the '59 Corvette convertible which he purchased after looking around for 18 months, from a collector in Queensland, and apart from some starter and steering niggles found it to be a very reliable car which he owned for the rest of his life.

He enjoyed club events and participated in interstate runs. He also travelled to the U.S. in 2003 to celebrate Corvette's 50th anniversary with about 12 other members and drove from Los Angeles to Bowling Green Kentucky along with 100s of Corvettes, sometimes travelling on the old Route 66.

Ian had poor health in his later years and would attend the club to have his '59 and an MGB put on historic registration.

His funeral was held Thursday 10th December 2015 at Centennial Park and we thank those members who were able to attend and say goodbye to a member of our Corvette family.

Model Corne

Carousel 1 was a British based model company which unfortunately has gone out of business. They produced a range of model race cars quickly gaining a reputation for excellence particularly for their Indianapolis race car range. Concentrating mostly on 1/18th scale cars they became one of the most respected producers

in the business. Between 1998 and 2009, seventy models were released covering the "golden era" of the famous race. They released a total of 8 Corvette models of which I have managed to get five. These models are in the same guality as Exoto with attention to detail right down to the wiring and in some instances fuel lines, the exterior finish is excellent, all models have opening doors and hoods and working steering. All of the models are early C3's with five based on actual race vehicles. The other 3 being blue, yellow and an awesome looking black high rise hood. Because they are now out of production and came in fairly limited production runs anyway they are starting to get up there in price. I have however recently seen a bundled group of four in boxes for an opening bid of \$500 plus postage on EBay which in my opinion wasn't bad value. If you are a serious
