The event will finish at 2pm, not the usual 3pm. Still time to register for the 2023 Nationals in Ballarat, come join us in what is shaping up to be a great event.

Membership Renewal Information



Dear Member.

I hope that this letter finds you and your family fit and well. After a recent audit of our membership records, it has been found that your membership has not been renewed for the coming year. We understand that you may have forgotten to renew, so please read the important information below. If you have recently sold your car, we understand that you are not renewing but if you could let us know so that we can update our records.

Important information for those on the Conditional Registration Scheme.

Membership of a Club must be paid and Log books must be signed before 31st December 2022 for vehicles to be able to continue to be legally driven on the road. If your log book isn't signed by this date then you will be driving an unregistered vehicle. This will also mean that if you are involved in an accident that your car will be uninsured for third party bodily injury insurance.

None of us want to see that costly event happen to anyone.

Issuing of new log books are required every 3 years.

If your log book is not signed, please notify the club registrar with the reason why (e.g. car off road for repairs or other reasons) before the 31st December 2022.

If your membership has not been renewed and the log book signed before the 31st December 2022, the Club is required to notify the DPTI of your Non-Financial Status. We will be notifying DPTI as of the 31st of January 2023 as to any members that have not renewed. DPTI may then cancel Conditional Registration for your vehicle within 7 days and your car will not be covered. Fines and or more can apply along with your loss of conditional registration. It is a requirement under the new code that the club notifies the department as a condition of maintaining our recognition status for the purposes of the scheme.

Your support in the form of membership and participation in the club is vital in ensuring our ongoing success as a club. Our club exists for its members and there are a number of benefits or activities available that members can enjoy. They include the following:

- A full colour newsletter each month by email.
- Monthly General meeting with supper provided.
- Club car runs on the first Sunday after each monthly general meeting (organised by any member that wishes
 to arrange a run. Feel free to ask for advice).
- Club dinners every third Friday of the month (arranged by club members and held at various locations around Adelaide).
- Access to Technical knowledge and expertise (some members have over 35 years' experience).
- Access to exclusive Club Merchandise.
- Lucky members draw for those present at the Monthly meeting.
- Organised regular events such as Club car runs both locally and interstate.
- Hosting of the Corvette Nationals when it occurs in Adelaide (generally every six years).
- A dedicated committee of volunteers.

Full Membership fees are only \$80 per year for Metro members and \$40 for Country members. Associate membership fees are only \$20. Log Books are \$10 so please check that yours is in date before paying your fees and include that in your payment. 

It was the night before when the Club hosted three of the team from GMSV for dinner and we had a chance to meet and talk with the team again.

During these conversations I was explaining the club's charity to Jo, Jodie and Rob from GMSV and how Noah was our grand-son was also a HeartKid. Sadly, the conversation also included Sean and how we had lost him to cancer just over a year before that. Un beknown to myself Jo and Jodie were in tears on hearing our story and the left the dinner with some thoughts on their minds.

It was from this meeting that I was to latter find myself on a list to get a C8, but I was asked to keep it quiet. To those of you that regularly asked me when I was getting a C8 I apologise for saying to you that it wasn't going to happen because I knew otherwise. I also didn't want to say anything until I had a signed contract in my hands and even did not tell our own daughters of what was happening for some time. Even at the club dinner in December I did not say anything after picking up the car that day.

On the 3^{rd of} December Cathy and I went down to take delivery of our new car. We were more that blown away with what we saw in front of us even though it may not have been Cathy's original colour choice. She is even excepting of the fact that it is a coupe and not a convertible. To this day we are still learning new things about the car and waiting to get the car to the run-in stage for a bit of extra fun.

Our only wish is that our son in law Sean could be here to see what we have as we feel that he sadly is part of the reason as to why we have this car.

It is that time again for those of you who are considering making the road trip to the Corvette Nationals in Ballarat_Victoria next year and plan setting time aside to travel as a group with your fellow club members to this very exciting event which has not been held for three years. Still only limited entry places available.

This is the first time this event has been scheduled away from Easter in order to avoid this extremely busy holiday period and access the necessary large venues to cater for this overdue popular and large gathering.

Please consider the following schedule which takes into account those who prefer not to drive large distances for various reasons as well as have a bit more social time to share with your travelling companions. As we have experienced in previous years the weekend goes a little less hectic to arrive the day before the main event, on the Thursday afternoon, to give more time to socialize and prepare your Corvette for the full-on weekend of activities. This means you will have to book and extra night at the Mercure Ballarat Hotel.

Total distance Adelaide to Ballarat via the Dukes Highway. 614kms. 6hrs 45mins.

Proposed "going to" travel plans.

Wednesday 22nd - Adelaide to Horsham. 426kms. 4hrs 45mins.

Thursday 23rd – Horsham to Ballarat. 188kms. 2hrs 15mins.

Proposed "return travel" plans via the Ocean Road.

Monday 27th - Ballarat to Apollo Bay via Geelong and Torquay. 190kms. 3hrs 30mins.


