Membership Renewal Information

It is that time of year again when membership renewal fees are due. Membership fees for 2025 can now be paid using the BSB and Account number listed in the club newsletter

The November (6th) and December (4th) meetings will be our annual membership and log book signing. To help these two meetings run more smoothly, it would be appreciated if members could do the following.

- 1) Pay your membership (eft preferably), or attend a meeting to make payment. If you have paid by EFT, please collect your receipt from the membership table.
- 2) If you are a Conditional member and have log books to be signed, please proceed to the log book signing tables with your CCSA membership receipt.
- Please bring with you the following: CCSA Membership payment receipt. Current Log book.

Current Registration Papers.

Please attend either the November or December meeting with the above so the team can sign your log book for the next 12 months, deeming your car registered.

Important information for those on the Conditional Registration Scheme.

Membership of a Club must be paid and Log books must be signed before 31st December 2024 for vehicles to be able to continue to be legally driven on the road. If your log book isn't signed by this date then you will be driving an unregistered vehicle. This will also mean that if you are involved in an accident that your car will be uninsured for third party bodily injury insurance. None of us want to see that costly event happen to anyone.

Issuing of new log books are required every 3 years.

If your log book is not signed, please notify the club registrar with the reason why (e.g. car off road for repairs or other reasons) before the 31st December 2024.

If your membership has not been renewed and the log book signed before the 31st December 2024, the Club is required to notify the DPTI of your Non-Financial Status. We will be notifying DPTI as of the 31st of January 2025 as to any members that have not renewed. DPTI may then **cancel Conditional Registration** for your vehicle within 7 days. It is a requirement under the new code that the club notifies the department as a condition of maintaining our recognition status for the purposes of the scheme.

Full Membership fees are only \$80 per year for Metro members and \$40 for Country members. Associate membership fees are only \$20. Log Books are \$10 so please check that yours is in date before paying your fees and include that in your payment. Membership update forms can be found on the club website (www.corvetteclubofsouthaustralia.com.au) and emailed direct to myself at the email address below.

We would love to see you at our club general meetings and events. The General meetings are held on the **first** Wednesday of each month. Doors open at 7.30 p.m. Meeting starts at 8.00pm at the Glenelg Baseball Club, Anderson Ave, Glenelg North.

So my last article was on Autoarts return to the Corvette line up with their C7 ZR1 which was a pretty impressive return. Since then they have been hard





at work designing and building a CB Z51. I had a blue CB by Maisto which I wasn't overly impressed with the colour was a bit off and to be honest it wasn't much more than a toy. I have a couple of True Scale and Top Speed CB's all of which are sealed models with no opening parts, made from resign. I have always been impressed by Autoart, yes they are expensive but they usually deliver on detail and quality, the majority of my collection is Autoart So after some research, I bit the bulit and ordered a rapid blue 1/18th, the purchase didn't go very

well and I will never buy another model from this company. I placed my order on 4th July and have only received the model in October, needless to say I wasn't very happy. Their communication was non existent and they kept blaming me or my credit card.

So back to the model, I am super impressed Autoart have out done them selves with this car. I was impressed by the C7 ZR1 but this surpases that in so many ways. The body colour is super crisp and the level of detail on





and closes with precission, the detail on the motor down to the leads on the engine is flawless. The rear hatch has working struts and the removable roof stows away perfectly, the interior is very detailed and almost close to Exoto in carpet quality. The windows are not crapy

plastic as seen on some models even by Autoart. This model wasn't cheap but you pay for quality. So here's the rub I ended up with two of these, so I have one I want to sell, mint in box for \$375. It is exactually as pictured in this article but has not been out of the box.

If there are incidents along the way, club members will be aware to provide support to those affected.


No changes to be made to the route of the event unless approved by organiser of the event.



Ask the Committee - Membership rule question.

A question was put to the Committee recently in regard to membership of the club if you do not own a Corvette.

Rule 3 of the Club Constitution covers this.

Rule 3.1.a - gives the elected Committee power over approval of any type of membership. Rule 3.1.d – states that Full Membership of the Club can be granted to persons who do not own a Corvette, as long as 80% of the Members are Corvette owners. This section specifically refers to Full Members and not Associate Members.

As the club has 237 Full Members this means we can have 47 Full Members not being Corvette owners. It would be incumbent on the Membership officer and the elected Committee to monitor this number.

The Committee will use this power to grant continuing membership to long serving members who sell their Corvette but wish to remain members.

If you find yourself being a non-Corvette owner, you can apply to the Committee to continue being a full member. The Committee will assess that application based on your years of membership and service given to the club over that time (eg Committee, Nationals committee, other commitments).


