Car of the Month KIWI'S KORVETTE

lan Bellman, Member No. 114 (.....you probably know him better as Kiwi) bought this bright orange beast back in 2012. It is a 1975 model with a 350ci engine coupled to an automatic transmission. The interior colour is saddle and options include the Chevy bowtie emblem embossed on the wheel trims and the addition of extractors.

Kiwi is the 4th owner. The vehicle was first based in Fyshwick, ACT in 1995 before being sold to a buyer in Queensland where it underwent a transformation. The vehicle was repainted from red to orange, new bumpers were installed, motor, heat shielding in the engine bay, conversion to right hand drive and kept in original condition. It was then relocated to SA in 2009. Kiwi

was given all of the paperwork detailing the work which had been carried out as well as a copy of the original sales brochure and handbook.

Since owning this Corvette, Kiwi has only had to rebuild the transmission and get the brakes done.

Kiwi enjoys the club runs that he has attended in particular his first time at 'Corvettes at the Port' back in 2013. One of the highlights for Kiwi was winning first place for 'Car of the Show' at the National Tattoo Convention held in SA in 2014.





I've been watching the reports on this particular brand for a while now and finally decided to splurge and get one. BBR are a company out of Italy producing high end models of most European sports vehicles in metal and the usual scales, their motto is: "We want the perfection of our models to surprise collectors all over the world, so that they too can experience the incredible emotion of possessing an exclusive object." The blurb on their web page states that 3 mates Balestrini, Barberis, Reali who had previously been doing small quantities of models started a factory in 1980 to fill the ever increasing demand for their products. In 2009 they expanded into the 1:18th world in both resin and

metal. Until the middle of last year I had never heard of this lot but they were advertising a limited release of the C7 in three colours, black, blue and yellow with a production run of only 200 units in each colour. This grabbed my interest as they were only in 1:18th and were going to be done in resin, the only other model of the C7 in 1:18th is by Maisto. Our friends at E-bay had the

coupe version of the BBR model starting at a whopping \$800 with their own store not much less they have since dropped to the \$300 mark. What really got my interest was their announcement of a convertible version of the C7 which was supposed to be released in November last year. As yet it hasn't surfaced in the stores or on the web and BBR's own store has only just made it available in white and red. Recently the company issued the pre-orders for a ZO6 version in limited colours of orange, silver and yellow again limited to 200 pieces, at the same time they announced a C7-R based on both the Le Mans and Laguna Seca versions of the cars so numbers 3 and 4 and 73 and 74 all in resin and limited to 200 pieces again. Popular number with this lot!. Now on their own web site http:// www.bbrmodelstore.com/ they have the C7-R and ZO6 models listed at 310 Euros which when converted comes out at \$458, the convertible version is 365 Euros or \$539 then you have to add in your postage. E-bay has these running at anywhere from \$500 to \$800 so they're not light on the wallet by any means. So after procrastinating for about 3 minutes the C7-R number 3 was ordered out of Hong Kong. So what do you get for \$500 Aussie dollars. The packaging tells that these guys are serious about their models for a start no plastic in sight the model comes mounted on a leather plate with a high quality metal plaque in a very heavy cardboard box with the car set at a slight angle. When you remove said



model from said box it sits flat so they obviously want you to show piece the whole thing. The model doesn't come off the stand with the fastening screws covered and the mounting pylons barely visible. The car is resin and is a one piece shell with no opening features. There is a huge amount of detail in the body work with all the clips and restraints for panels represented the rear



brake ducting is an insert piece as are the head and tail lights. The rims are metal with what appears to be rubber tyres and the roof has metal aerials. The front and rear splitters and diffusers are separate parts from the moulded body and both these and the rear wing have a carbon fibre look to them. Paint and decals are exceptional quality with the slightest of edges to be felt on the stickering. There is a detailed interior which is a little hard to see as it is black and the limited amount of light let into the car. The only thing that lets the whole product down is the windows they are light cellophane or plastic but I guess this was done to represent to light weight glass on the actual car. There isn't a motor or underside to this vehicle. So is it worth the \$500 is the big question? Honestly I would have to say no it is worth about half of that, in a few years when the 800 models that are out there are long sold it might command that sort of money. It is in the same league as Exoto when it comes to detail but their models all come with opening parts and a

drive train. At present it is the only 1:18th C7-R you can get your hands on so I guess you can ask what you want for it. The rumour mill has it that Maisto will be releasing a ZO6 version of the C7 shortly so I think I will wait for that but the two are not in the same league.

Holden Corvette in 2017

THE iconic Chevrolet Corvette sports car is expected to appear in Holden showrooms as the brand's hero car, once manufacturing comes to an end in 2017.

The boss of General Motors' international division, Stefan Jacoby, said Holden would have a "halo model" after the V8 Commodore dies.

Mr Jacoby stopped short of confirming which car it would be. There are only two V8 performance vehicles in the GM line-up that could possibly fit the new Chevrolet Camaro or the next version of the Corvette. The Camaro does not have right-hand drive.

"We will bring a true sports car to Australia for the brand Holden," said Mr Jacoby. "It will be something which fulfils the requirement of a true Holden sports car."

Corvette chief engineer Tadje Juechter said: "We want the Corvette to come to Australia.'

The ongoing success of our club is dependent on an enthusiastic group of members putting up their hands to help with running the various components of the club.










