

2015 Corvette Z06 and the C7R along side each other, at the North American International Auto Show, Chevrolet released this photo and nothing else. What can be seen the image are the

profile Michelin Pilot Sport Cup tires on lightweight-alloys. Carbon-fibre side skirts and fender-flare extensions. Chevrolet are promising us the most track-capable

Corvette ever," The new Z06 has been designed to deliver supercar levels of performance through unique powertrain, chassis and aerodynamic features. Hence the C7R sitting along side it for the week. What we do know is there is a new Jake logo (At right). Rumours now abound across the internet that an



8-speed automatic transmission designated the 8L90, capable of handling over 700 pound-feet of torque, is in development. The 8L90 is about the same size as the Corvette's current 6L80 six-speed, but with two extra gear ratios, a ratio spread of 7.0, a shorter first gear for better launching, and three speed sensors for improved shifting. All of this information has supposedly come from an SAE paper which has since been retracted and modified but not before the Corvette forums got hold of it ! Only time will tell.

The convertible was released for sale last month and Chevrolet kicked the party off with a limited release Premiere Edition, which comes loaded with everything you would want to stuff in a performance vehicle a gutsy exhaust system, electronic limited-slip diff, adjustable magnetic ride suspension. Don't forget the Corvettebranded luggage from Thule. Chevrolet will build just 550 of these convertibles, only available in the dark green Lime Rock with the brown suede interior . The Premiere Edition will set you back \$77,450 (US)


